Learning Objectives for Khmer – Grade 2

At the completion of Grade 2, learners will be able to:

Listening

- Listen to others read out loud to answer questions
- Listen to stories and summarise stories
- Recognise different rhythms
- Be able to complete word dictation
- Identify new vocabulary read aloud

Speaking

- Sing with different rhythms
- Blend basic words with or without subscripts
- Build self-confidence through bravely sharing ideas in class

Reading

- Recognise the consonants, vowels and independent vowels
- Recognise groups of consonants and changing sound with second group of consonants
- Understand the meaning of new vocabulary
- Blend consonants and vowels to form words
- Build capacity to read common words with subscript and without subscript
- Improve reading fluency with familiar texts

Writing

- Spell common words correctly
- Write the subscript when necessary
- Correctly copy sentences from the board and books

Learning Objectives for English – Grade 2

At the completion of Grade 2, learners should be able to:

Listening

- Recognise the different sounds of all consonants and vowels
- Listen attentively to a story and know details
- Show respect when others are speaking and wait for a turn
- Follow 2-3 step instructions

Speaking

- Use correct pronunciation
- Speak clearly and audibly
- Express ideas in complete sentences
- Participate in a variety of discussions on different topics
- Use an expanding vocabulary to ask and answer specific questions
- Recite short poems, rhymes, songs, tongue twisters and verses

Writing

- Copy text from the board or books with correct spelling and punctuation
- Spell simple sight words
- Phonetically spell unfamiliar words
- Construct short sentences
- Write from left to right in a uniform and properly spaced manner

Reading

- Recognise word families
- Read familiar text
- Know common sight words
- Blend sounds into words
- Begin to use strategies to decode unfamiliar words
- Comprehend simple text that is read by an adult

Learning Objectives for Mathematics – Grade 2

At the completion of Grade 2, learners should be able to:

Number sense

- Read and write Khmer and Arabic numbers up to 1000
- Compare numbers in the hundreds, using greater than and less than signs
- Know the difference between odd and even numbers
- Create number families in addition and subtraction
- Recognise the relationship between multiplication and division facts
- Count forward and backward to/from 1000
- Understand and use ordinal numbers
- Identify place value up to 1000
- Recite 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times tables

Computation

- Add two digit numbers to two digit numbers without carrying
- Write equations both horizontally and vertically
- Subtract one digit numbers from two digit numbers without borrowing
- Begin to carry and borrow for addition and subtraction
- Know addition and subtraction facts to 20, using base 10 numbers
- Mentally solve simple addition and subtraction problems
- Mentally solve multiplication and division facts in 2, 5 and 10 times tables

Patterns and Forms

- Identify missing numbers in patterns
- Describe and make patterns in symmetry
- Create and solve problems using words and symbols
- Create mirrored form drawings that are balanced

- Find patterns in geometric shapes

Learning Objectives for Social Sciences – Grade 2

Social science topics are presented in various lessons throughout the year, both in Khmer and English. They may be specific lessons or included in classes such as cooking, gardening, drama and movement. This includes not only particular subject areas, such as life cycles or hygiene, but also life lessons that are practical, interesting and help children build skills they will use every day for years to come. Social sciences in the early grades is centred on the experience of interacting with the world and each other to develop social awareness and life skills. When subjects are presented in more depth in later grades, children already have an understanding and connection to the way the world works and their place in it.

At the completion of Grade 2, learners will be able to:

Social Sciences

- Participate in, and prepare for, specific activities, festivals and holidays
- Recite poems, rhymes and songs related to nature
- Know familiar animal characteristics, behaviours and habitats
- Describe a favourite animal, both physical qualities and behaviour
- Recognise various cycles in nature such as the butterfly, seed cycle and human physical growth
- Discuss and reflect on kindness, inclusion, compassion and respect
- Prepare simple meals using a variety of cooking skills and different kinds of foods
- Demonstrate safety in travelling and swimming - during field trips, real life situations and swim class
